

Digital skills for the 4th Industrial Revolution

Objective of programme:

Support teaching and learning systems to transform to the digital era and capacitate educators, lecturers and practitioners across the sector to acquire the digital skills and competences in line with the Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR). Curriculum transformation and innovation are mandatory to address the 'new normal'.

This programme is non-credit bearing and will be delivered utilising a virtual platform.

Duration: 8 days - Attendance for all eight (8) days compulsory

Dates:	Module 1:	7 and 8 August (2 Days)
	Module 2:	10 and 11 August 2023 (2 Days)
	Module 3:	15 and 16 August 2023 (2 Days)
	Module 4:	17 and 18 August 2023 (2 Days)

<u>Module 1</u>:

- <u>Section 1</u>: Learning theories which provide the theoretical frameworks, understanding of learning outcomes, supported by a literature review on global trends in flexible, online, and blended learning and teaching and quality assurance.
- <u>Section 2</u>: Facilitate different methodologies, education and training styles, and techniques within an online and/or blended environment.

Module 2:

- <u>Section 1:</u> Technologies which have and/or are emerging in enabling flexible (meaning online, blended, flipped classroom, open learning, MOOCs) learning and teaching.
- <u>Section 2</u>: Automated Management Information Systems to underpin online learning.

Module 3:

• <u>Section 1</u>: Design and develop curricula for online and blended learning environments.

Module 4:

• <u>Section 1</u>: Design and develop a credible and valid quality assurance framework for online and blended learning and teaching environments, considering digital credentialing. This includes facilitation, assessment, moderation.

Assessment:

Albeit this is a non-credit bearing programme an assessment is compulsory and will be conducted by the training provider.

Who should apply:

This is a non-credit bearing programme aimed at educators, facilitators, and practitioners, and or any person working within online/blended learning environment at a private provider institution.

Who cannot apply:

Following the criteria provided by the ETDP SETA, you will <u>not</u> qualify if:

- You are unemployed.
- Not employed in the Post School Private Provider space.
- If you have not been declared competent or have not completed previous ETDP SETA funded programmes through APPETD.

Applicant requirements:

- Applicants must have a qualification higher than Grade 12 or equivalent to Grade 12.
- Applicants must be proficient in utilising basic virtual platforms i.e. Zoom. Microsoft Teams.
- Applicants must have access to suitable computer/laptop/devices/internet connectivity.
- Applicants must be available and attend for the **<u>full eight days</u>** of training.

<u>Compulsory</u> documentation to be submitted:

- APPETD Beneficiary registration form
- Letter of employment
- Recently certified copy of your ID (no older than 3 months)
- Recently certified copy of your highest qualification only (no older than 3 months)
- APPETD Funding agreement letter
- Completed ETDP SETA Grant agreement form

Important notes:

- Seats are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
- Applicants that have forwarded all the required documents will be notified of successful registration within 4 days of receipt of documentation.
- All certification to be **<u>dated</u>** and not older than 3 months.
- Applications without all supporting documents may be disqualified.
- Applications with non-certified or illegal documents may be disqualified.
